

HOMEOWNER MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST





MONTHLY

- □ Change air/furnace filters
- □ Test smoke and carbon monoxide detectors
- □ Flush toilets and run water in bathrooms that are rarely used
- □ Check gutters for ice blockages and icicles (during winter months)

- Check gutter for leaves and debris
- □ Clean garbage disposal

QUARTERLY

- □ Inspect crawlspace/basement for water leaks or other moisture
- □ Inspect and repair caulk in bathrooms and kitchen areas
- Clean inside of refrigerator
 Clean baseboards
- □ Check showers/sinks for drainage issues

Repair drain blockages as needed

SEMI - ANNUALLY

- □ Wash & rinse range hood w/ hot soapy water
- □ Lubricate tracks of garage doors
- □ Clean insides of window tracks

Inspect weather stripping on doors and windows (Spring/Fall)

- Deep clean all windows
- □ Change batteries in smoke and carbon monoxide detectors
- □ Flush out water heater to remove sediment
- □ Have HVAC unit inspected (Spring/Fall)
- □ Reverse direction of ceiling fan (Spring/Fall)
- □ Clean gutters/downspouts by removing all leaves and debris
- Check home for hazards (door/window locks, loose shelves and knobs, etc.)

YEARLY

- □ Pressure wash exterior of home including siding, windows, and decking
- □ Check roof for leaks or damaged shingles
- Clean out clothes dryer exhaust vent
- □ Test auto-reverse function on garage door
- Remove and rinse window screens winterize outdoor faucets
- □ Get termite inspection
- Have chimney cleaned and inspected
- Deep clean all carpets
- □ Aerate and seed your lawn (Fall)
- Repair damage to window screens as needed
- □ Vacuum refrigerator coils and clean refrigerator gaskets
- □ Check fire extinguishers

KITCHEN

- □ Store cleaners in a locked and/or high cabinet.
- Keep oven and dishwasher handles free of dishcloths and rags.
- □ Install cabinet locks.
- □ Install an oven door lock.
- Store appliances that are sharp like blenders and food processors out of reach.

LIVING AREAS

- ☐ Hide wires behind furniture or use a wire hider.
- Cover outlets.
- Use safety gates restricting access to stairways.
- □ Install sliding door locks.
- Secure televisions and heavy furniture like bookcases to the wall.
- Cover sharp corners and edges with guards and bumpers.

BATHROOM

- □ Keep cleaners, chemicals and all medicine (including vitamins) in a locked cabinet.
- Secure toilet lids.
- Store items like curling irons, hair dryers and flat irons in a locked or high cabinet.
- □ Install door knob covers to help prevent access to the bathroom.

GENERAL SAFETY

- □ Install safety gates at the top and bottom of the stairs.
- Have car seats checked to make sure they are installed properly.
- □ Keep doors closed and restrict access to rooms that are not child friendly.

BEDROOM

- □ Keep mini blind cords separated/out of reach.
- □ Secure furniture to the wall.
- Cover outlets with outlet protectors or furniture.
- □ Install bed rails.
